PROFESSIONAL

INDUSTRIES – once again choosing all is a great option, but you can also click on “Add Industry” and type in other selections. A pre-populated drop down will appear and you can multi-select.

EMPLOYER - you are free to choose a particular employer if you prefer to speak/consult with certain companies only. Click “Add More” to find specific employers.

SERVICE - Select the service in which you are interested. If you are not sure what you need, just select all.

LOCATION - Choose the location that you would prefer the mentor from. However, since this tool and the services are virtual, the location of the mentor may be inconsequential unless you are looking to work in a specific area.

LANGUAGE – Choose language, if applicable.

MAJOR - Choose the major you are pursuing, or perhaps hope to pursue in the future. Note variations in the way a degree appears. As an example: BSc, is also listed as H.BSc, Bachelor of Science, Honours Bachelor of Science etc. (See page 3 for more)

TIPS

Many individuals pursue a career beyond the “normal” scope of their degree so keep your search options open and locate more advisors.

The “Add _____” (industry, location, degrees etc) function, it should be noted, are criteria that has been populated based on individual Advisor profiles and not on a pre-defined set of criteria. Due to subjectivity and variations in formats, users should consider searching by wider criteria and using the multi-select function to ensure best search results.

The key to finding a ‘good’ mentor is to try multiple search techniques and see which gives you the list you are most comfortable with.

E-Visors is a database and as such the person you choose to connect with might not be available at that time, so do not hesitate to re-connect with them if you get no response the first time.
