## **Guidelines:**

- 1. How long and in what capacity have you known this student?
- 2. Please comment, to the best of your ability, your knowledge of this student in terms of:
  - How this research experience will further this student's academic/research training
  - Knowledge in the proposed research area
  - Motivation and commitment to this learning experience
  - Personal suitability and maturity
  - Resilience and resourcefulness

The Letter of Reference should be written on university letterhead and signed by the referee.
