PURPOSE: To offer an opportunity for student involvement in the student conduct processes under the Student Code of Conduct (SCC) and the Residence Code of Conduct (RCC) by providing an alternative to hearings conducted by University administrators/staff.

Position Description

- ✓ Operate out of a restorative justice and procedural fairness/administrative law framework.
- ✓ Hear cases, make decisions and recommend fair and educational sanctions for student conduct matters in residence and in the larger campus community.
- ✓ Consider the needs and interests of those harmed/impacted and of the community in balance with those of the individuals involved in incidents on campus.
- ✓ Act in a mature and professional manner and be consistent in interpretation and respect for the Codes.
- ✓ Recommend changes to the SCC or RCC for the consideration of the appropriate authorities/committees.

Commitment

Minimum of 3 hours every two weeks plus ongoing training and development.
